

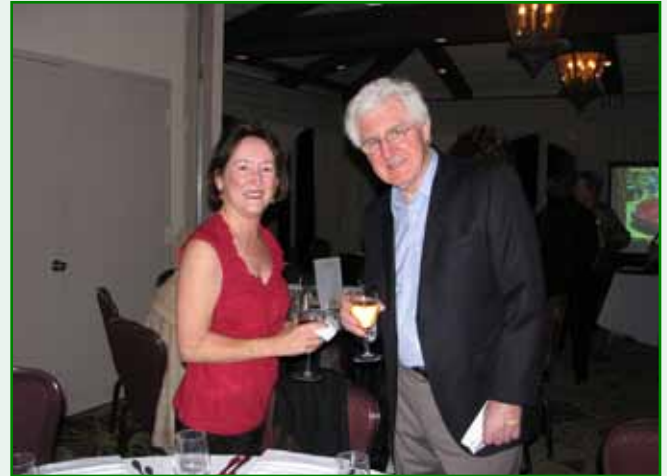
# 2011 Election Dinner

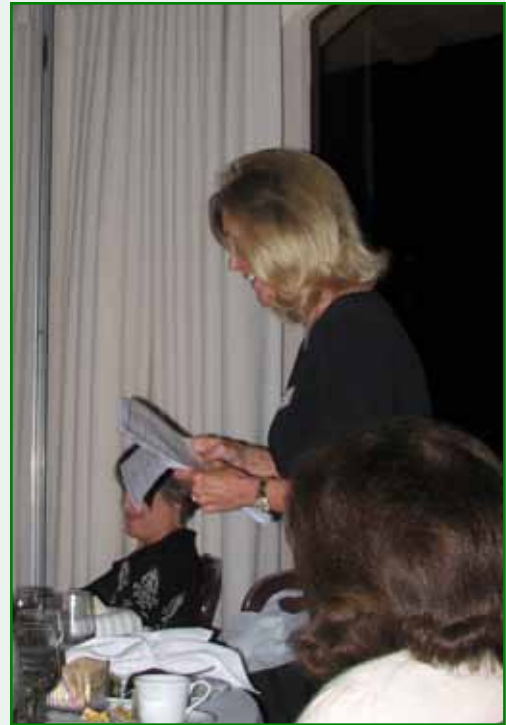
