

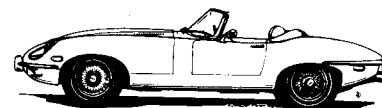

MEMBER'S PROFILE  
Glenn and Margie Simpson

Glenn and Margie Simpson joined the Jaguar Club in 1974. The club was small with about 20 members on the roster and it had a very vigorous recruiting program. The Fitzgerald's (in a station wagon) followed a puzzled Glen and Margie (in their new 2+2 E-Type, V-12) for three miles until they finally stopped them and asked the Simpsons to attend a meeting. They have both been very active in the club since that time. Margie served as Treasure in 1978 & 1979 and Glenn was president in 1980 & 1981, and this year he is Concours Chairperson.

Glenn owned his first car when he was fourteen and his interest in automobiles has evolved from hot rods and dragsters through Corvettes and Porsches (he raced a 911S with the Porsche Club) to Jaguars. In 1974 they traded a Speedster which Glenn had restored, for the V-12 E-Type and the next year they drove it daily for one and a half years while they restored it. Finally it was retired for Concours and special events. In 1980 the Mark IX placed third in National Competition and the next year it was second with 98.41 points (first was 98.81). Last summer they sold the Mark IX and bought a 1950 Mark V and are re-entering the restoration cycle.

Glenn's enthusiasm for Concours events is demonstrated by the fact that he has shown three and four automobiles at one time. This effort required three solid weeks of preparation before the show.

Glenn now drives a 1977 XJS and Margie owns a 1976 XJ6L. Glenn and Margie are certainly among the Club's staunchest supporters and participate in every facet of the Club's activities.

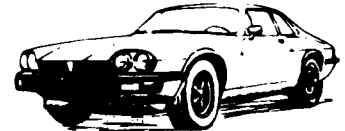
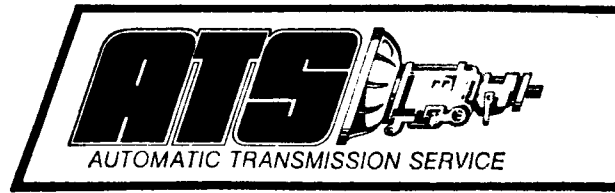
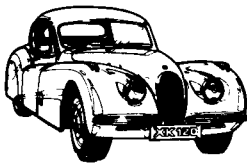
