# JAGUAR DASHBOARD CLOCKS MODIFICATION

On certain models including E-types, the dashboard clock does not work off the car's battery but is driven by a 1.5-volt dry cell battery. In some cases the original setup uses a hard-to-find non-standard cell and battery box, making it desirable to convert the clock to permit the use of a standard C size battery. A new battery box which provides the necessary external connections is required.

The actual conversion is simple: clip off and discard the leads to the old battery or battery box, leaving as much wire as possible attached to the clock; obtain a Radio Shack, Archer No. 270-402, C size battery box (current price is 79 cents), and connect its leads to the existing leads from the clock. (Provide sufficient wire slack to permit subsequent battery replacement without having to remove the leads or installing a connector.)

Correct electrical polarity must be maintained: the battery + to the clock + and the battery - to the clock -. The battery must be inserted in the box with the top + terminal against the small round contact and the battery bottom - terminal against the spiral spring contact. + wires are usually red, - wires are usually white or black. The clock will not be damaged by reversed polarity, it just will not run.

Finished connections should be insulated with tape from each other and from other wires, and the entire battery box should be wrapped with plastic tape to keep it from contacting surrounding metal surfaces. A rubber band will secure the battery box behind the clock.

Experience has shown that the above works satisfactorily on our E-types of 1969 & 1970 vintage.

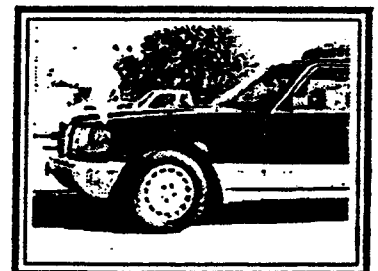

The month of July is going to be a busy one for San Diego Jaguar Club members!

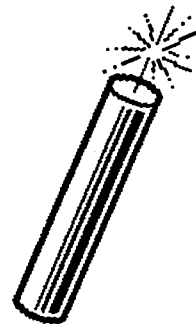
