





What is the difference between a Daimler and a Jaguar? Whats the history behind this "link"? The English Daimler and the German Daimler-Benz are both named after the same guy, Gottlieb Daimler. The English Daimler company was started in the 1890's to build cars under a patent license from the German company. The two companies paths diverged about 1900 or so, and the English company went on independently until 1960, when it was bought up by Jaguar. Daimler's own body styles were phased out, but the Daimler V-8 engine was used for a while in the Jaguar Mark2 body with a

simler fluted grille and other trim. From the late 1960's on every Daimler has been an upscale version the equivalent Jaguar sedan, with a Daimler fluted grille and other trim. Since I've had my 84XJ6 (Aug 1993) I've been keen on adding a theft deterent means to it. A traditional way with electric fuel pumps is a cut off witch. With this in mind, when I was re-hosing my fuel injection, I liscovered the fuel pump relay. The fuel pump relay picks-up ground from chassis wiring so it would seem that it would be easy to interrupt that gound pin at the relay, extend a wire (only one required) into the cabin to hidden switch that controls this ground to the relay. However, unlike all my other cars, I could not find a readily available hole in the Jag's irewall to run this wire!!!!! That sucker is really well sealed off!! Any other ideas?????
