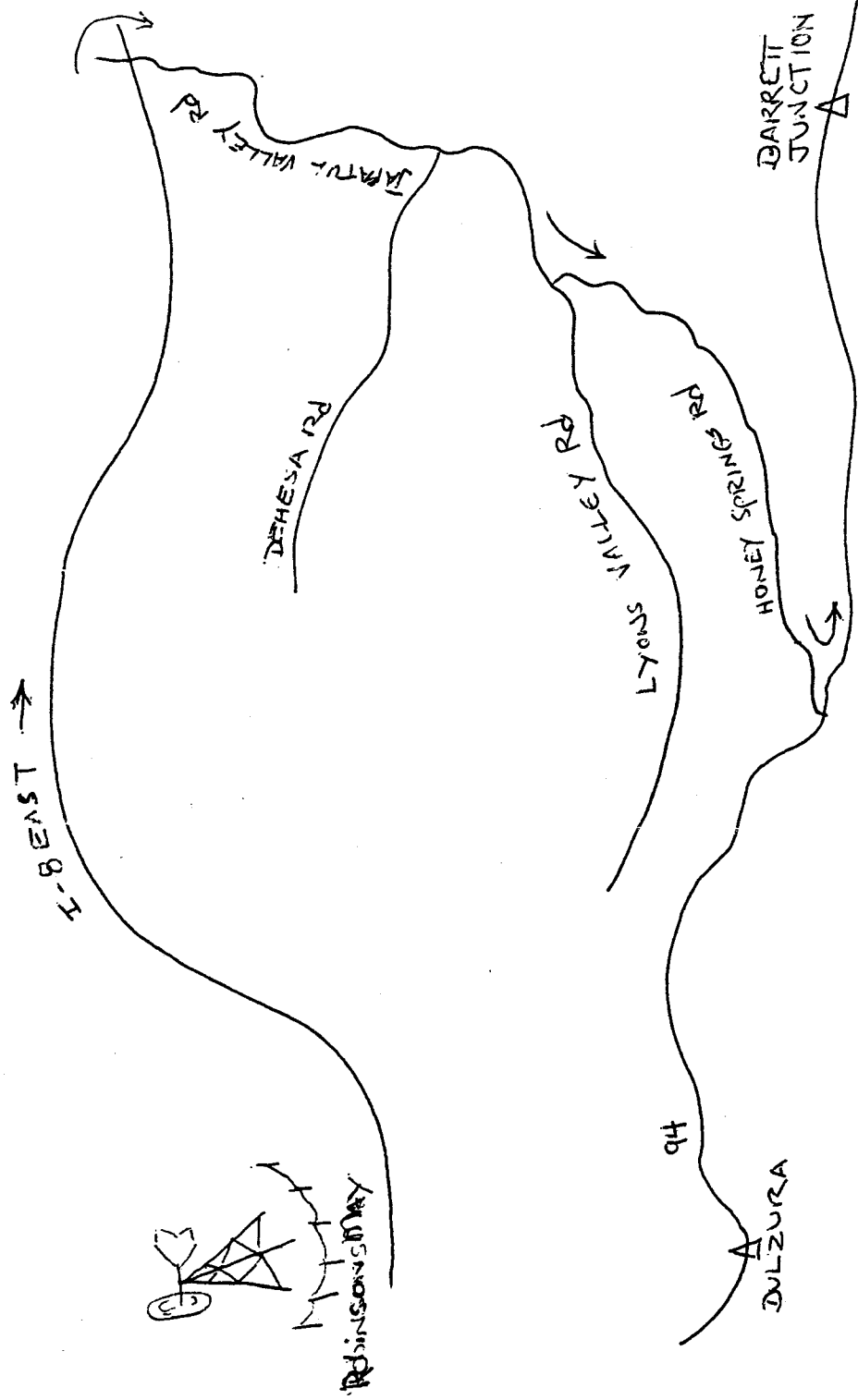

# AGM 1994

## Charlotte, North Carolina

The Carolina Jaguar Club did an outstanding job.

Bill Streitenberger was elected President and Jerry Nell, Vice President of JCNA.

Outgoing President, Barbara Greyson received the Andrew White Award.

JCNA Club insurance is in effect. This does not replace your personal insurance. We have received a credit card proposal for JCNA members with no fee involved.

Membership: Cards are on the way. Next year our JCNA dues must be paid by February 15, or pay a penalty which has been increased to \$3.00 per member. San Diego dues have been paid for 1994.

David Shapiro, JCNA Representative: This is the fourth year Ford productivity and efficiency have improved. Customer satisfaction is now number 6 up from 25. The paid membership for new car owners is being discussed. The new XJ-6 with 12 and 6 cylinder will be introduced in October, with lines adapted from the Series III. The 6-cylinder will have 40 more horsepower.

A Concours for the Southwest Region was approved for San Francisco using the Regional name only. Names on concours forms are still a problem for the computer. Be sure and list your name the same every time. Scoring in the Driven Class remains the same. If a car is in a trust and is entered in a concours, one of the trust must be a JCNA member. JCNA has 577 licensed judges, and each team must have one licensed judge. Class 16 remains the same for one more year. I have a copy of the JCNA Budget, if you are interested, please give me a call. Is your early Jaguar in the CJA Register? Call me for information.

A new E-Type approved guide is available through JCNA. The other guides are being upgraded and may be ordered. The 100,000 mile-plus club now has over 50 members.

The high speed driving event on the Charlotte International Speedway was a tremendous success. After a brief indoctrination, JCNA members were suited up and followed a pace car around the track. Bill Streitenberger attained a high speed of 135 miles per hour. A NASCAR shop tour followed the driving event.

A seminar was held on how JCNA was viewed by its members:

- Concour: scores too high; judges aren't qualified; rules too hard to find; can't drive and compete with restorers.
- JCNA is: dues too high; not enough benefits; not enough driving events; not enough social events.
- Jaguar Journal has no value and not enough interest.
- What JCNA should be: financially sound and independent; a clearing house and organization for all Jaguar owners; a friendly and outgoing organization. We should work to make JCNA the premier association of Jaguar enthusiasts fulfilling the needs and interests of its members.

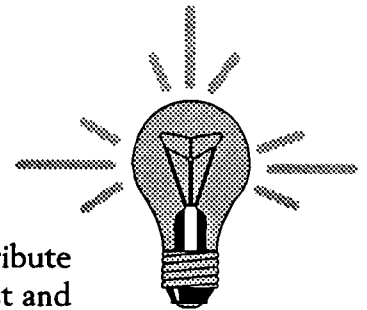


- In 1972 SDJC president was Charles (Chuck) Flack.

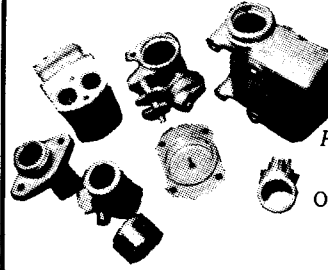

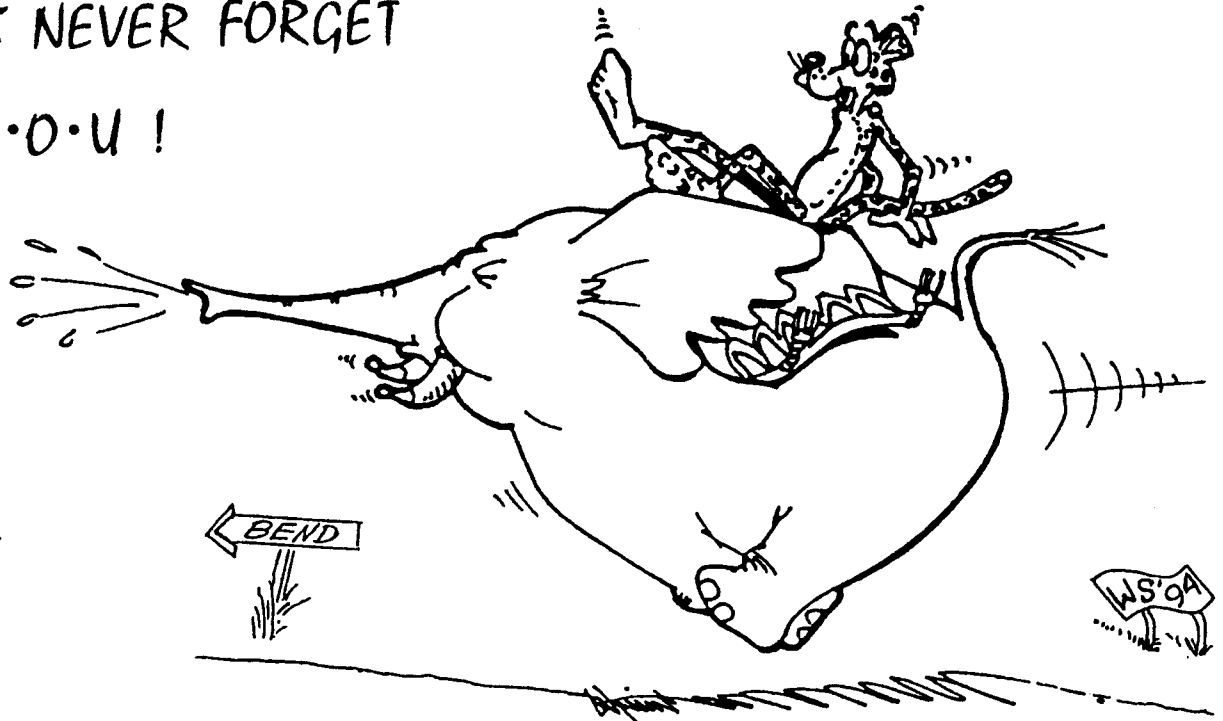
