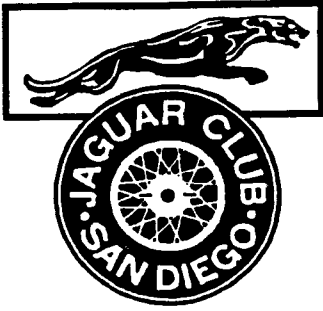

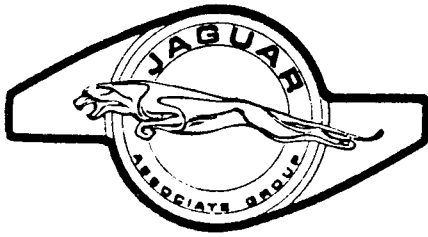

Following my telephone call of today's date, I hope that I am not too late for you to be able to include some of the following information concerning our club's involvement in the above named Concours, in the August and September issues of your club's newsletter. I regret not being able to convey the advice sooner but it was only yesterday that I finally received agreement from Jaguar Cars as to the extent of the company's support for the event.

This restricted viewing is necessary because the X300 won't be shown to members of the public until the end of September due to the press embargo established by Jaguar Cars and the Ford Motor Company. Also on display but publicly, there will be an XJ220 model and a 1995 XJS convertible outside the Jaguar tent in which the X300 will be housed.

Jaguar Cars Inc., are offering all West Coast Jaguar club members this unique opportunity to see the new model in the "flesh" before it is launched, as an indication of the company's appreciation of the support of JCNA clubs during the tough economic period that Jaguar is slowly emerging. The gesture is made by Jaguar Cars on the understanding however, that NO photographs of the X300 will be permitted.

Our club intends to make the weekend of September 17/18 memorable for all local and visiting club members. A special dinner will be held at Paola's the night before the show and overnight accommodations have been arranged at the San Jose Hilton at the remarkably low rate of \$79 per room. Paola's is one of San Jose finest restaurants and it is located just across the street from the concours site. It is within walking distance of the San Jose Hilton where secure parking is available under the hotel, for show cars. Trailer parking has also been arranged conveniently adjacent to the show field.

The cost of entering a Jaguar in this prestigious concours is a minimal \$10 fee that will admit two adults and two children and provides each entrant a complimentary program. This Silicon Valley Concours D'Elegance is a charity event organised by the San Jose Lions Club which plans to donate all the net proceeds to selected local charitable societies a list of which is available if of interest. I would mention in conclusion that the closing date for entrants wishing to have their cars listed in the program, is September 4th. Later entries for the JCNA contest will be accepted up to September 15th"

## GENERAL RULES FOR JUDGING

### CONCOURS AND DRIVEN CLASSES:

1. The decision of the Concours Chairman and Judges will be final.
2. Component Team Judging/Single score sheet method will be used.
3. No entrant (or car preparer) shall be a judge of a class in which his or her care ( or the car which they prepared/helped prepare) is entered.
4. Underbody areas will not be judged.
5. Mechanical function of wipers, horn and exterior lights will be checked.

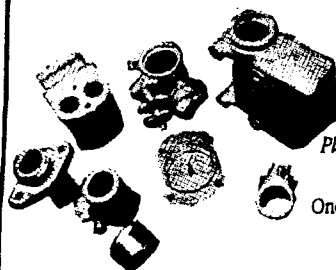
### JCNA CONCOURS CLASSES:

1. All cars will be judged by current JCNA rules including: top up, hood and boot lid open. Spare tires/wheels will be judged, but need not be removed unless size, condition or the adjacent areas cannot otherwise be viewed.
2. Exterior, interior, engine compartment and boot areas will be judged.
3. If an item or entry is judged non-authentic, the judge **MUST** advise the entrant who may then offer documentation to prove authenticity.
4. The car owner or a member of his or her immediate family must be present during judging of the car.
5. To qualify for year-end JCNA championships, entrants must be a member of a local JCNA club, at the time the time the car is judged.

### JCNA DRIVEN CLASS:

1. Exterior, interior, lights, horns and wipers will be the only judged.
2. Cars must be driven to Concours, no trailering or towing.

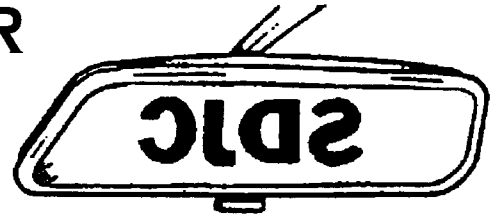

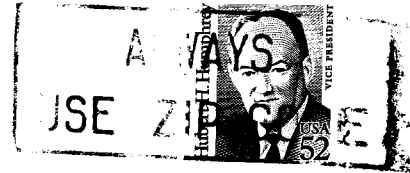
