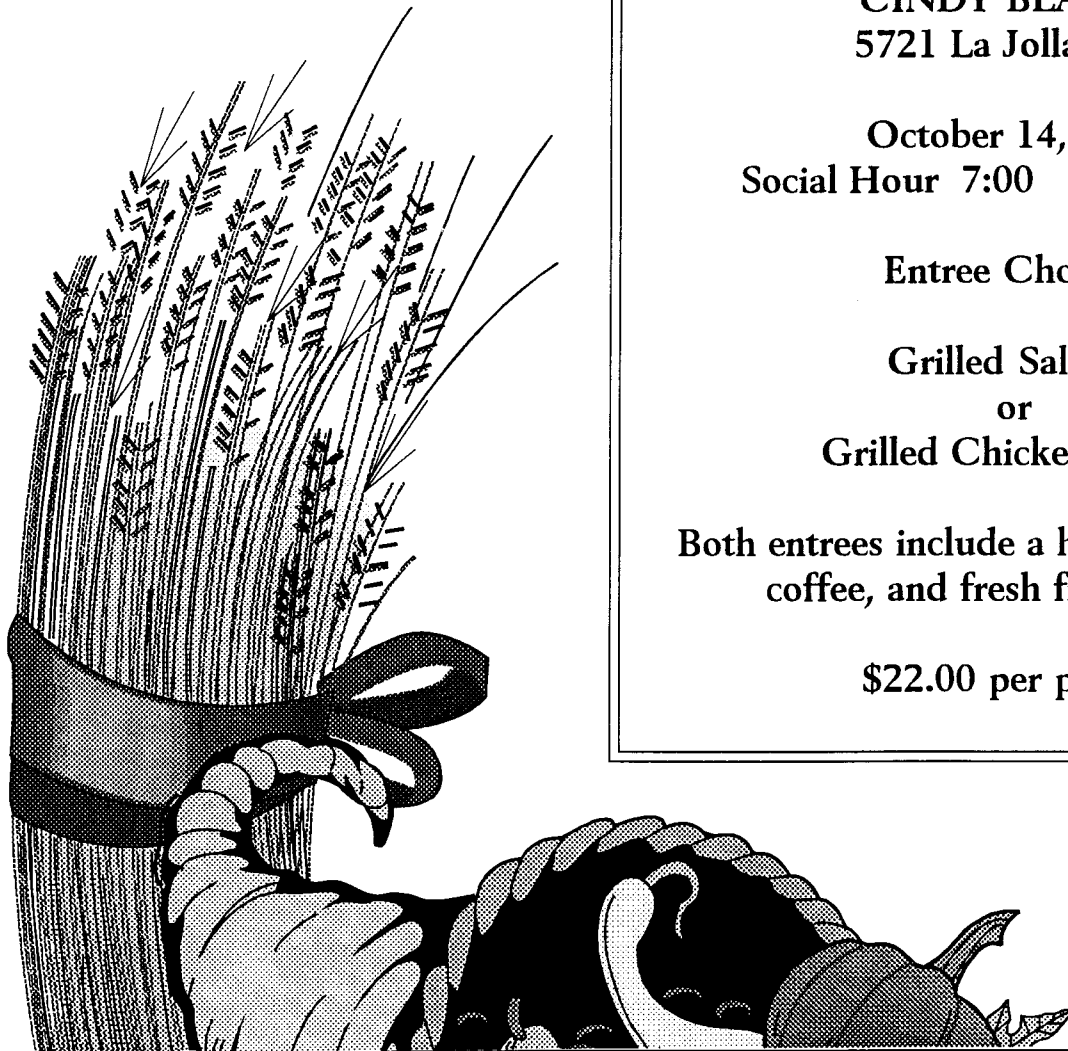

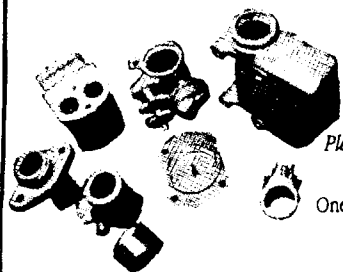

**JCNA BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING  
KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI  
SEPTEMBER 10, 1994**

The new Vice President of Public Affairs is Mark Miller, effective October 1. We wish John Crawford the best of luck.

Barbara Grayson missed this meeting because of illness. Let her hear from you.

There are high expectations for the restyled, re-engineered XJ Series sedans. For the first time Jaguar is in the black under Ford. For the first eight months North American sales were 10,185, 22% over this time last year.

**Jaguar Journal:**

The revenue received from Jaguar Journal is stagnant. JCNA had hoped it would increase each year. The AGM and Biannual Meets will be advertised free of charge.

**Membership:**

Membership renewal begins in October so checks will be in by December 31, 1994. Members will be dropped by JCNA on February 15 if not renewed by the deadline. Out of the \$17 in dues to JCNA, they net \$11, and this is the primary source of income.

JCNA has 5,100 members, of which 1,200 are Members-at-Large. In the last eight months there were 713 inquiries for JCNA membership. Of these, 566 originated at JCI.

If you did not receive your JCNA Membership Card, it probably went to your old address. This is in the process of being corrected. Let me know if you don't receive yours.

Welcome Jaguar Owners Club of Jacksonville, Florida, Club #12, a new JCNA Club.

Dick Howe has made up a new Club Directory format. Make sure he has your club date of origin and number of members along with current officers and addresses.

**Concours and Rallies:**

Next year, no concours will be allowed on the Biannual weekend, July 5-8, 1995, so mark your calendars. An additional form is needed for insurance coverage for your events.

The present Judges' Test was voted, "too vague", and a new test will be forthcoming. The number of licensed judges in the Southwest Region under the old system is: JCNA Club #1 - 19, #2 - 12, #3 - 18, #4 - 39, #5 - 13, #6 - 10, #7 - 23, for a total of 134.

Rallies are up this year, a total of 12 sanctioned so far. Get your results in.

The **Protest Committee** has received three inquiries this year and has ruled on two.
