




RETURN OF THE CATS!

Big news for all motor racing fans — Jaguar will return to endurance racing in 1995. After a notable absence from the 24 Hours of Le Mans in 1994, due to homologation difficulties and the subsequent withdrawal of the works sponsored TWR team, the fast cats will return for this most prestigious event in the auto racing calendar. Three XJ220's will run at Le Mans under the team ownership of Hugh Chamberlain, and two cars will compete in the other major endurance races. Chamberlain was responsible for Lotus Sport/Chamberlain Engineering effort in the BRDC National GT Championship during 1994, taking the Class B title.

The 1993 Le Mans cars were prepared by Tom Walkinshaw to IMSA GT regulations. Body work was detachable so there may have to be considerable modifications to meet new ACO regulations. Jaguar is not supporting Chamberlain's effort financially, but will provide technical assistance.

In addition, Richard Hassan, owner of a road-going 220, plans to enter two cars in the Le Mans spectacle, raising the prospect of five XJ220's racing in the June 1995 event.




IN THE REAR VIEW MIRROR




MEMBERSHIP SURVEY
