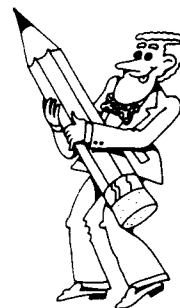

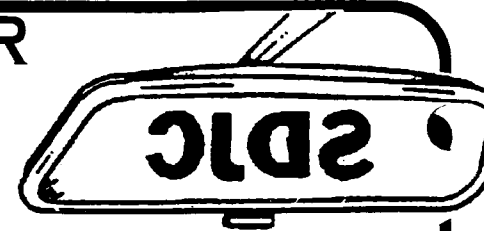
I'm pleased you are enjoying our events and dinners. We'll continue to offer variety. I'm pleased to receive your suggestions or comments. Please join us if you're available.

CAR CLUB BADGES

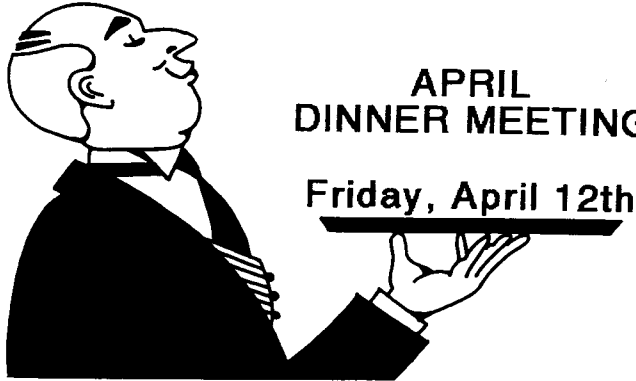

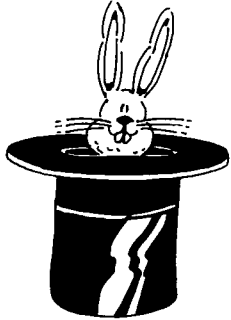

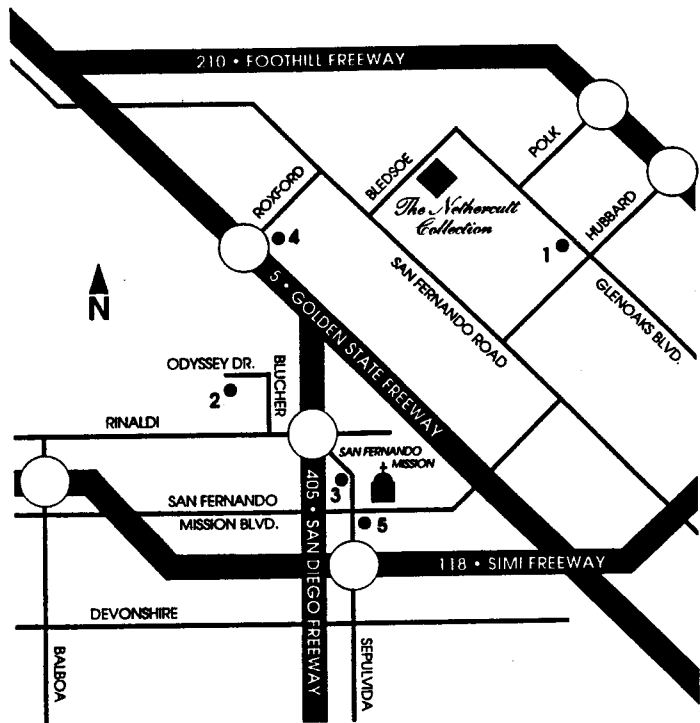

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

San Francisco

March 9, 1996

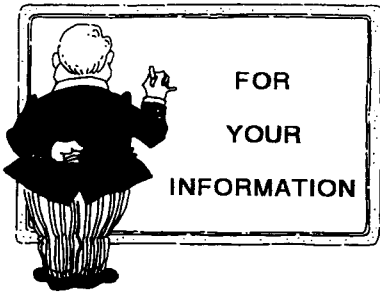
Here are some highlights of the '96 AGM I just attended March 9th. Detailed Minutes will be forthcoming from Dick Howe:

- I. Jerry Parkhill of the Canadian XK Registry was elected President for 1996, and Tom Palisi of Florida was elected to the Executive Committee.
- II. A Judges' Manual is under review, but was put on hold for one year.
- III. There are between 4,500 and 5,000 copies of the Jaguar Journal mailed to members each month, including Jaguar dealers. The Jaguar Journal has doubled in size over the past four years.
- IV. Membership in JCNA as of March 2, 1996, was 4,016, an increase of 185 members. Sales of Jaguar regalia (trophies, etc.) showed \$2,000 profit. JCNA net worth is \$109,808. This is one year operating expenses, if all advertising stopped.
- V. Jaguar Cars intends to support JCNA. World sales are up 30% with a 20% increase in North America.
- VI. Concours:
 - A. 1995 participation was 788 in Championship, 588 Driven and 72 in Class 16. If a participants Membership Number isn't known, be sure the region and host club number is on the sheet.
 - B. It is the responsibility of each local club to publish in its newsletter the concours scores.
 - C. It was proposed that interior of gas cap enclosures, ashtrays, glove boxes or other storage compartments be open for judging. This failed.
 - D. The Judges' License Examination remains the same. A proposal by Dick Cavicke to have a Chief Judge appointed for a one year term was passed.
 - E. A proposal by David Iwerks to have a 15-minute time limit on judging a car was passed.
- VII. Money was appropriated for establishing an 800 number and reprinting the JCNA brochure.
- VIII. In honor of Fred Horner, a new award has been created, "The Fred Horner Sportsmanship Award". To qualify all competition must be done with the same car, with highest aggregate year-in-placement in concours, rallye and slalom programs. All concours classes and divisions are eligible.

In the recent Regional Representative election, there was a poor response from the clubs in North America. Make sure your vote is counted in the next election. Let your representative know your viewpoints and your concerns so these can be expressed at the JCNA Business and AGM's.

Tracy will discuss **Jaguar fuel injection and judging XJ and XJS cars**. I will explain JCNA judging to anyone interested in becoming a judge and go over the latest judging rule changes for those already in the program. I also hope to have some samples of the new Judge Check Lists that our "class experts" have been working on.

If there are some specific technical areas you would particularly like to have discussed, please give Tracy a call at 274-5191 so that he may be prepared with parts, equipment, etc.

The next Judge Training Session is planned for either **May 25th or June 1st at Classic European**. The focus there will be XK's and E-types. Check the May-June Jaguar Tracks for confirmation.

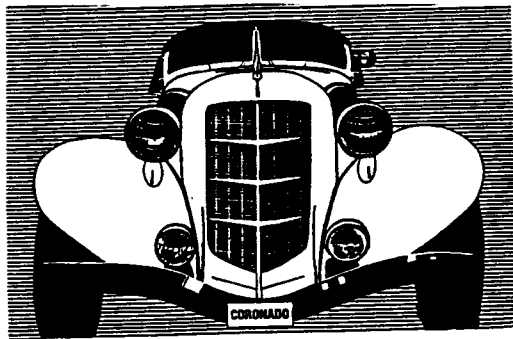
