SAN DIEGO JAGUAR CLUB BOARD MEETING MINUTES February 17, 1999

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by President Norman Bild at 6:35 at Cush Jaguar.

Members Present: President Norman Bild, Treasurer Tony Starks, 2nd Vice President Roger Townsend, Historian Randy Prine, Special Everything Marilyn Prine, Secretary John Greenbush, Newsletter Editor Gail Hoffman, and Director John Yoder. Guest Larry Bornstein.

Minutes: January 1999 submitted and accepted.

Treasurers Report: Accepted as submitted. There were 96 newsletters mailed with postage of \$114.40, and printing cost of \$146.42.

Membership: Roger Townsend submitted 3 names for membership; Steve Browning has an 89 XJ6, R. Lou and Ilene Lepis have an 83 and 86 XJ6, Larry and Sandy Bornstein have an 99 XJS Saloon. It was unanimously agreed to welcome them to the club. Roger reports 132 active memberships, with 29 members not renewed to date.

Dinners: The club dinner at Kearnys turned out to be something less than pleasant. Complaints included late or no service for drinks unacceptable service for dinner, and coffee and desert being charged for and never being delivered. The possibility of a refund was being looked into.

Norm suggested the Club have four or five restaurants that adequately accommodate the Club, and rotate those. Obviously, anyone bringing a new restaurant to the Club's attention would certainly be welcomed. Good service, good food, and room to accommodate the Club are prime considerations.

We have a letter from David Robson, a Jag owner visiting from Canberra, Australia, this summer who would like to get together with Club members. He will be in the area over the 4th of July, discussed including Mr. Robson in a Club BBQ

The club received a letter from Southwest Regional Chairman, inquiring about our interest in a regional meeting in Las Vegas, for the year 2000. It would include ten Jaguar Clubs in the Southwest Region. One of the considerations was the central location for all ten clubs. We invite comments on any interest in this kind of inter-club gathering.

Adjournment: Meeting adjourned at 7:45 p.m. The next Board Meeting will be March 17, 1999 at Cush Jaguar.
