

Assembly Point: Parking lot of "Oscar's On The Pond" restaurant on Rancho California Road in Temecula. From I-15 North take Rancho California Road East a short distance past Ynez Road to the restaurant on the right.

Time: Departures from Oscar's starting at 10:00 am. The restaurant doesn't open until 10:30, but the manager has promised that coffee and bagels will be available for us at the take-out counter from about 9:30.

Thornton will close in the early afternoon for a jazz concert (call 909-699-0099 for ticket information), and Callaway will be dominated by a huge charity lunch. Mount Palomar Winery has a small deli that will build take-out sandwiches to order, but they admit that service is slow on week-ends.

After lunch you can continue your tasting, hit the backroads of Riverside County for some interesting driving, or take a walking tour of Old Town Temecula which is loaded with antique shops and historic buildings. Temecula's annual Kite Day at Paloma Del Sol Park is also scheduled for that afternoon.




