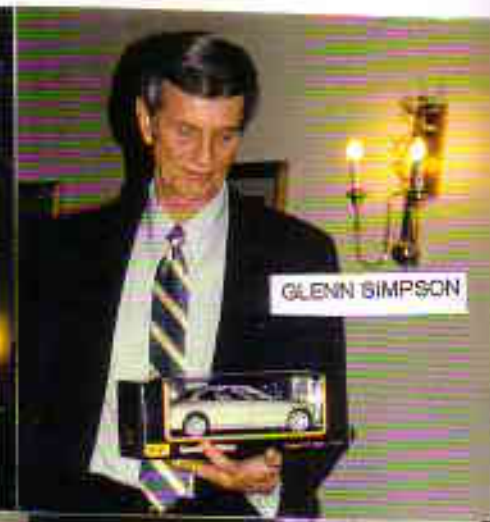

Board Meeting  
Wednesday, December 15, 1999

Minutes

President Norman Bild called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m. in the Cush Jaguar office at 5202 Kearny Mesa Road, San Diego, California.

Present: Norman Bild, 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President Bob Anderson, Treasurer Dee Ward, and Board member Dennis Dater. Excused: 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President Roger Townsend and Secretary Pat Harding. Members attending Dick Cavicke, Hank Callihan, Barbara Anderson, and Dee Bild.

Minutes from November 17, 1999, were presented with a motion by Dee Ward to approve, seconded by Dennis Dater, motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Dee Ward reported the current balance is \$6,016.12 with \$3,000.00 allocated for next year (includes zoo donation), \$900 over last year budget. She stated if there were no objections she would write off \$23.00 in uncollected accounts receivable and purchase a computer program with checks and deposit slips. She would like to reinstate the policy of having the dinner host/hostess put any uncollected dinner expenses on their credit card and she would reimburse them prior to credit card payment. There being no objections to any of her requests, a memo to be sent to the Dinner Coordinator stating policy.

1<sup>st</sup> Vice President, Bob Anderson presented proposed telephone tree "Caller Guidelines" to cover previous problems and concerns of the callers (see attached). It was recommended that guidelines be sent to activity Host/Hostess.

Bob presented a SDJC Millenium Calendar to cover club activities for 2000. The proposed activities were discussed. John Duncan, SDJC 1<sup>st</sup> President, requested club involvement for the May Memorial Day Parade in Palm Springs. He would like to have Jag convertibles to carry the Medal of Honor recipients. This could include overnighter and show. Classic Road Rally's and local show involvement were considered. More family type activities such as picnic and museum visits. Saturday night Pops concert. Bob will look for volunteers for some of these activities.

2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President Roger Townsend's report, was made by Norm Bild. He presented the new member applicants:

Motion to approve applicants as presented seconded by Bob Anderson. They're being no objection motion passed.

A request for a motion to approve James McPherson as Cush Jaguar Dealer Display Coordinator, was made by Dee Ward and seconded by Bob Anderson, motion passed. Discussion followed on the current membership pin options and costs, tabled for further investigation.

Board Member Dennis Dater reported on his and other members concerns over Friday night dinners, specifically the Christmas formal. Dee Ward stated that was the only night open at her club. Other locations were discussed and Dee will investigate. It was noted that the first six months of dinners have been scheduled for Friday nights. Bob Anderson said he would talk to the Dinner Coordinator to possibly set up other days.

Jaguar Tracks: Gail Hoffman is retiring to travel (lucky). Norm and Dee Bild will publish the January issue with the help of Dennis Dater who is in the business. Hopefully we can find someone with the time and the desire to be an editor?

Dinners: Previously discussed

Old Business: Vacant positions were discussed with a unanimous request to nominate Randy Prine to serve as Board member until 2003. Several members were proposed to fill the one-year position they are as follows: Stuart Bartfeld, Stuart Smedley, and James MacPherson. They will be presented for vote at next membership meeting.

Hank Callihan reported on the San Diego Automotive Museum request for car clubs to get interested in renovations. Currently they are restoring an XK120 at 16<sup>th</sup> & E Street in S.D. Parts and volunteers with expertise are needed. The site is open Wednesday and Saturday from 9-2 p.m. The museum also has requests for display cars for shop center openings and like, concerns for liability and security were discussed. Hank gave us a legislative update for Jaguar Tracks.

Dick Cavicke discussed Tusher Trophy criteria requirements and the need to have designated Policy and Procedure. Other items that should be included, Most valuable member, Car Trophies, Telephone and Dinner coordinator procedures. Documentation of procedures to be presented by the members. Dick stated a need for more entertainment at dinners other than review of past and coming attractions. Bob Anderson stated a need to really welcome new members. Dick brought up the possibility of reinstating the fines for not driving a Jag to the meetings. Fines were dropped due to the many complaints of members that it took too long to review all members, couldn't hear with others talking during the presentation. Bob Anderson thought we might just have those that didn't bring a Jag state why not. Other entertainment options will be determined. There being no further business Dick made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Bob Anderson motion passed.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:40 p.m.

Telephone Tree**

Proposed Caller Guidelines  
December 15, 1999

The official newsletter of the San Diego Jaguar Club, *Jaguar Tracks*, is the primary source of communication between club members, the officers of the club, and the sponsors, hosts, and organizers of various club events. The Telephone Tree callers operate as a group of facilitators to accept reservations for those events requiring reservations, i.e., dinner meetings, but which do not require written entry forms or prepayments. While members are free to call the event host or hostess to make reservations, the Telephone Tree is a convenient way to funnel these reservations to the host or hostess. Callers are not salespersons whose job is to solicit and promote attendance at any event, nor is it intended that they replace *Jaguar Tracks* as the primary means of communication.

The following guidelines are provided for callers so that efforts will be uniform across the club, and so that callers do not burden themselves with extraordinary efforts to be sure that absolutely every member is contacted and personally invited to attend each event.

1. The coordinators will maintain a current club roster and mail updated lists of calling assignments to the callers by the last Friday of the month before the event.
2. Callers should complete their calls and advise the host or hostess by phone on the first Friday or Saturday of the month of the event.
  - 2.1. If the call is answered by an answering machine, the caller should leave a message. No further calls to that member need be made relative to that event.
  - 2.2. If there is no answer to the first call, the caller should call back at least two more times. After this, no further calls to that member need be made relative to that event.
  - 2.3. If the response to a call is "No", no further action is necessary.
  - 2.4. If the response to a call is "I'll call you back if we decide to go", no further action is necessary. Requests to be called later should be declined, and the member should be advised to call back or to call the host or hostess.
  - 2.5. If the response to a call is "Yes", the caller should be sure to record the number of people who will attend and what entrees they have selected on the Telephone Tree Sheet.
  - 2.6. The tally sheet should be returned to the coordinator as soon as possible after the tally has been reported to the host or hostess.


2.7. The caller should remind the "callee" about any other events taking place that month and record any "yes" or "no" responses on the tally sheet for return to the coordinator.


3. The coordinator will send e-mail request for reservations to all members with listed e-mail addresses on the last Friday of the month. A follow-up e-mail ("last call") will be sent by the Thursday before the event.

4. Anyone who calls or sends an e-mail to make reservations after the report has been made to the host or hostess should be advised to call the host or hostess direct to avoid confusion and to shorten the communication line.

5. The coordinator will talk by phone with the host or hostess during the weekend before the event to develop a semifinal count and list of those who have made reservations. The host or hostess can use this count to guarantee the number of attendees, and can add to it as he or she receives late reservations. The coordinator will then prepare a check-in list of those members who have made reservations and mail it to the host or hostess after this call. Adequate space will be left to add late reservations, to total the money received at the event, and to transfer custody of the money to the treasurer.

6. The coordinator will call the sponsors of other events that month with a count of all members who will attend that event.

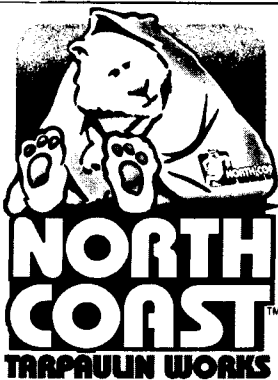

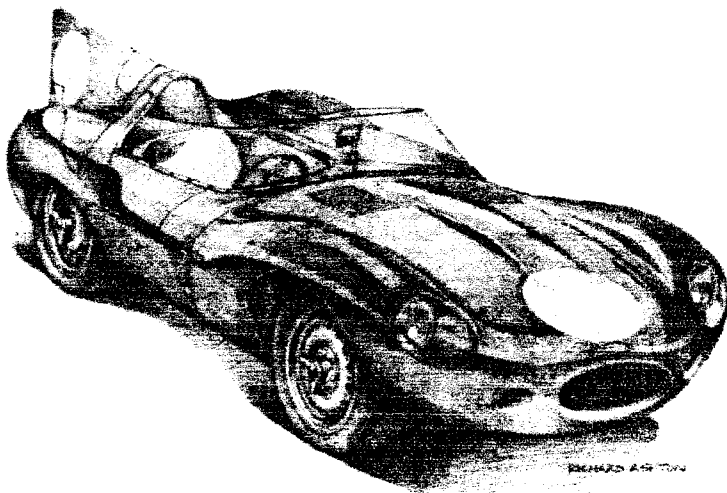

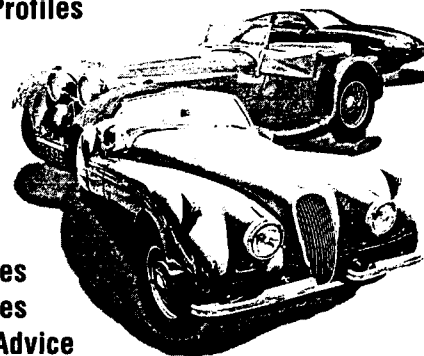
