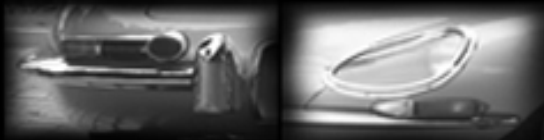

Minutes from the November 9, 2005 Meeting**

President Hazel Beck called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

Members present: Hazel Beck, Gayle Askren, Dennis Dater, Nedra Rummell, Roger McDonald, Paul Novak, Curtis Parker, Sandy Millard*, Katherine Partain*, (*=functional chairperson) Members Absent: Grant Rummell

A. Board Member Reports

1. President's Report

Outgoing President Hazel Beck expressed her thanks to the board. She enjoyed working with everyone and is looking forward to doing more in the future and assisting incoming President, Katherine Partain, in 2006.

2. First Vice President (Activities) Report

Gayle reminded everyone of the upcoming Holiday Gala at Shelter Pointe Resort on December 11th. There was a discussion to possibly invite Jack Brandais, author of the Weekend Driver to speak at an upcoming event. Gayle reported the January event will be held at Jack and Guilio's in Old Town one either January 13th or 14th.

Hazel Beck expressed concern regarding the April British Rolling Car Day scheduling on Easter Sunday. In the past, the event has been scheduled on Saturdays, resulting good participation. She will discuss alternative scheduling with the Rolling BCD planners (see New Business).

Other possibilities for future events include a Thai restaurant, Imperial House, Peterson Museum, and an event in association with upcoming JONAT tour. Curtis Parker suggested occasional events could be held at member's homes, which were well attended in the past

Nedra Rummell reported planning is underway for the February 11th dinner at Lake San Marcos Country Club which will be a Valentine theme with special invitations to new members.

Dennis Dater addressed the lower attendance levels for dinners and events. The board agreed the dates need to be published two months in advance and members receiving Jag Tracks a little earlier would help. Discussion continued regarding the cost of dinners and locations options. Hazel, Katherine and Gayle will develop and submit an "Event Survey" to Nedra to include with the membership renewal packages.

A member emailed Hazel expressing concern regarding guests subsidies for the Holiday Party. Hazel answered each member may bring one guest at the subsidized price; all other guests will pay the full price.

3. Secretary's Report

The minutes from the October 19, 2005 meeting were distributed electronically with corrections and additions by Nedra Rummell. Secretary's report accepted and approved via electronic distribution.

4. Treasurer's Report

Treasurer's report was distributed, reviewed and accepted. To date, the Port Commission permit fee refund check has not been received.

B. Committee Reports

Membership: Nedra Rummell reported one new member application – Mark and Ann Jurczynski of Monarch Beach. Paul Novak made a motion to accept the new members, seconded by Dennis Dater. Motion carried unanimously.

Jag Tracks: Katherine is working on the December issue and reported Diane McDonald submitted an article describing the adventures of the Golden State 400. The deadline for the December issue is November 15. Katherine continues to look for a replacement editor. She has also contacted Dennis Dater for a quote from Allegra to publish the newsletter for a couple of months until an editor is assigned; she has agreed to complete the January issue in December. Dennis will meet with Katherine to answer a number of questions to pass on to the graphic designer to determine costs. He suggested the newsletter be reduced in size for costing purposes. Katherine also reported she plans to submit Paul Novak's column for the annual JCNA article and photo competition.

Paul Novak reported he has set up Ocean Beach Upholstery for the December issue. He will continue with his "The Cat Came Back" article documenting the restoration of the 57 MK VIII from the start of restoration, March 2005.

C. Old Business

C. Old Business (continued)

Event Photography: Roger McDonald will be traveling and unable to take event photos from January 14 thru the end of February.

Member Interest Cards: The new cards printed by Allegra were distributed.

Concours Registration: Hazel Beck received an email questioning the possibility of charging \$10 for display cars at the 2006 Concours. Currently, other clubs charge \$20-\$25 for display cars. The board agreed there are costs associated with display cars, for registration packets, etc., and was in agreement that \$10 is not excessive charge.

D. New Business

JONAT 2006: Hazel Beck reported the preliminary schedule and routing. Hazel will talk to the British Rolling Car Day officials to see if the date could be moved from Easter Sunday to the 15th to tie into the JONAT tour. Hazel again will be the Sector Coordinator for our segment of the tour. Paul Novak is back again as our Assistant Sector Coordinator. She will accept the hand-off of the Tour in Irvine at the Premier Auto Group. The hand-off to the Arizona Sector date and location is still undetermined. Although JCNA did not work with the previous JONAT tour, it will be assisting in 2006 and hopes every Jaguar club along the tour route will participate.

Nedra Rummell motioned the meeting be adjourned at 7:50 PM, seconded by Curtis Parker. Next meeting will be held on Wednesday, January 18th, at 6:30 PM in the Cush Jaguar Board Room.

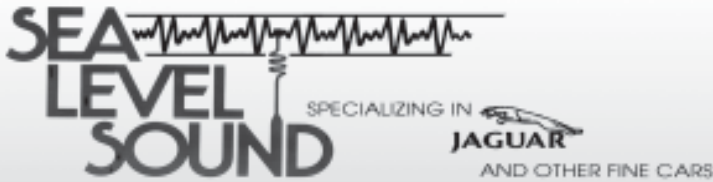

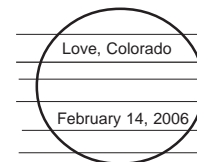
