member would “adopt” a new member and help him/her through the first year. Paul Novak already volunteered to sponsor one particular couple because they have the neatest cars.

Work will begin soon on updating the club roster for 2006. This year’s cutoff date for submission will be March 10. The new roster is scheduled to be issued in April. Castle Phelps has agreed to edit the roster for 2006. Katherine will contact him and encourage him to start on it soon.

Jaguar Tracks: Katherine Partain provided the board members with a point paper regarding options concerning the publication of the Jaguar Tracks. She is having a hard time recruiting a member from our own ranks to take the editing position. Dennis Dater submitted an estimate for Allegra to do the job. Katherine has asked the Board members to study the point paper and discuss the matter further at the next meeting as an option if no one steps forward from the club to take the position.

We are also looking for an Advertising Manager. Several prospects were discussed. Paul Novak recommended one member who was highly qualified. He will call her regarding the post and report to the board at the next meeting. One of the directors, Roger McDonald, is also thinking of taking over this task.

Auto Museum: Katherine Partain reported that we need to file the 2006 contacts form and make our \$20 payment to the museum. She gave the completed contacts form and an Expense Report form to Grant to pay the 2006 dues.

Dennis Dater wondered aloud whether we still had one of our members as a member of the California Car Club. The answer was “no” and lively discussion followed. Apparently the purpose of the club was to be involved on lobbying activities in Sacramento to keep up with automotive legislation that may adversely affect the club. Katherine said Mike Partain would research the cost and value added to join.

C. Old Business

AGM: AGM is coming up on March 30, 31, and April 1, in Seattle, WA.. Katherine Partain reported she, Dick Cavicke, and Randy and Marilyn Prine will be attending. The board discussed paying for registration and the award banquet for our club delegates. Katherine will find out from Dick Cavicke what costs, if any, were covered last year by the club. The club needs to select two delegates to represent us at the AGM. In the past, delegates have been Dick Cavicke and Randy Prine, although Hazel was a delegate one of the years she was President. The subject was tabled until our next meeting, while Katherine gathers more information on the subject.

Hazel Beck asked the board to give some consideration regarding sponsoring the 2008 AGM. It was pointed out that although San Diego would be the perfect venue, a lot of work would be required from all club members. The matter has been taken into consideration. Nedra Rummell has done some research in the past and mentioned that this would be a major undertaking. Katherine thinks the club at large ought to be polled to find out if they want to do this.

Judges Meeting: Hazel Beck reported the Judges Meeting was held as scheduled on December 10, 2005. Subjects covered were scoring problems and judging errors. JCNA has a Cleanliness and Condition Judging Guide in the works and should be available this year. She said she would like to see an increase in the frequency of the judges’ breakfast meetings to two times a year, once after the Concours and the second just prior to the AGM.

JONAT 2006: Hazel Beck reported the 2006 JONAT will begin in Seattle on April 2 this year. Hazel is the coordinator for the San Diego Sector and Paul Novak is the Assistant Sector Coordinator. The dates for our sector will be announced later but will probably be around Easter time. Our club will be picking up the route at the Premier Auto Group in Irvine. She said we had one of the highest turnouts last year. While several of the women wore their tiaras to the lunch at Jaguar Headquarters in Irvine, let the minutes reflect that Paul Novak did not wear a tiara during the 2004 tour. The hand-off to the Arizona Sector date and location is still undetermined.

2006 Holiday Party: Nedra Rummell and Diane McDonald will Chair/co-Chair. The \$500 deposit has been paid and the date is set for Saturday, December 9, 2006.

D. New Business

2007 Holiday Party: The venue was discussed. It was decided to return to The Shelter Point Hotel in 2007. The date selected was Saturday, December 8, 2007 and we need to pay \$500 to reserve the date. A motion was made and passed to approve paying the \$500 deposit. The deposit is non-refundable.

2006 Concours: Hazel Beck is this year’s Concours Chair, scheduled for Sunday, August 6, 2006. Hazel is submitting the sanctioned event forms to JCNA. Hazel will also apply for monetary sponsoring from the JCNA.. The Port Commission fee of \$187.50 to rent the Spanish Landing venue was paid in August of 2005 when Hazel reserved the date for the 2006 Concours. A \$500 refundable cleaning deposit will need to be paid in late May or June. The first committee meeting will be scheduled for May.

Training Display - Launching the new XK: Jaguar Irvine is holding training sessions throughout the month of March at the Four Seasons Aviara Resort in Carlsbad in connection with the launch of the new XK. They are looking for XK ancestors for display at the Aviara Country Club. A preliminary request from Greg Sanguinetti at Jaguar in Irvine, included one example each from the XK, E-Type, and XJS ranges, as well as one each from the early XK8 (1997) and late XK8/XKR (2004 onward). Greg is going to forward Katherine’s contact information to two women at Jaguar who are in charge of this training, who will let Katherine know what is really required and the benefits to be offered to people who offer to display their cars at the training sessions.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:59 PM. Next meeting will be held on Wednesday, February 15th, at 6:30 PM in the Jaguar Kearny Mesa Board Room.

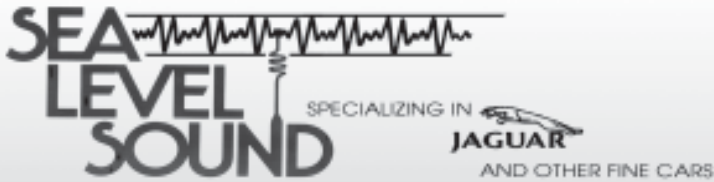
